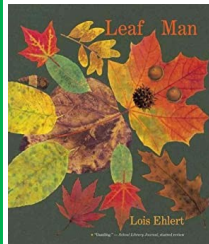

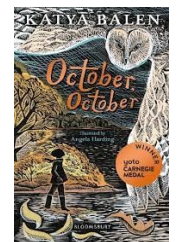


### Autumn Inspired Books

These books are available to borrow from libraries, buy in physical form, read on kindles or as audio books!



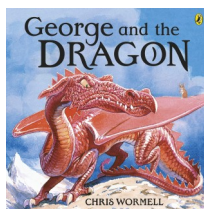
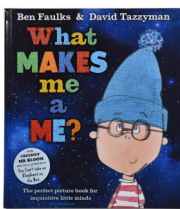
### New Children's Laureate

Sparkes has written an adventure which will ignite your imagination! It is full of daring, courage and of course... magic!

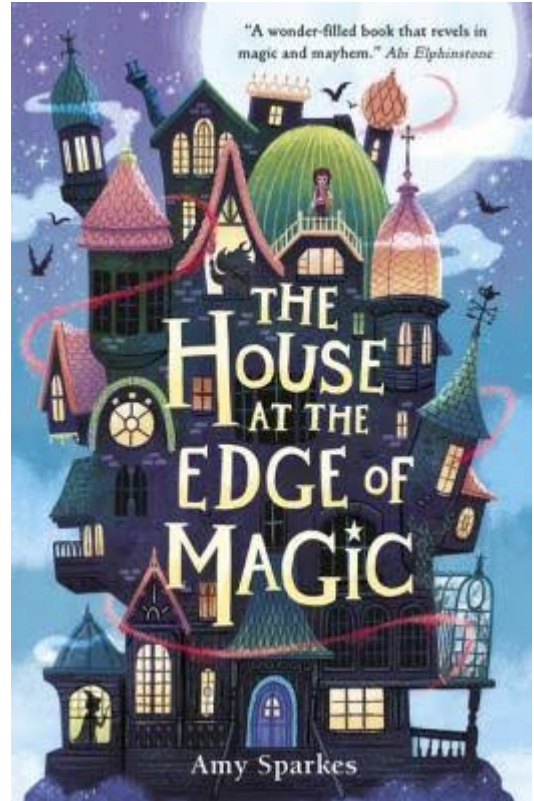
