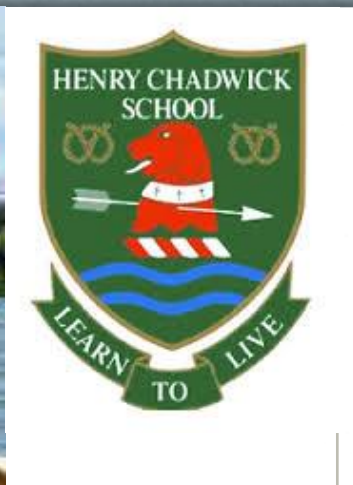

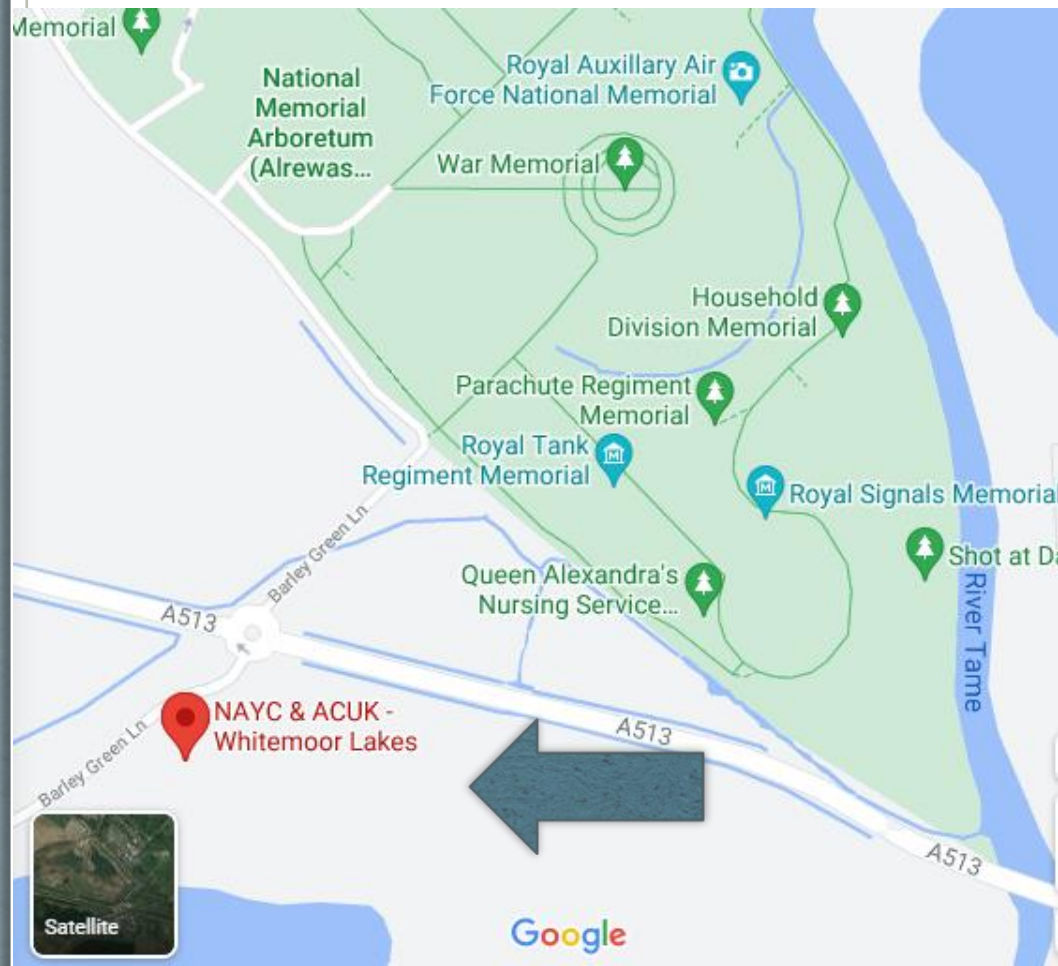

Lunches can be ordered from school for that day if required.



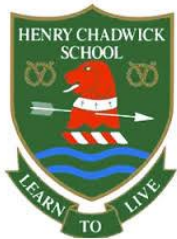
