Dear Mums, Dads and Carers,

Y3/4 VISIT TO WOLSELEY WILDLIFE CENTRE - 22nd November 2024

To support the work we will be doing as part of this term's topic, the Stone Age, we have arranged to visit the Wolseley Wildlife Centre, which is run by the Staffordshire Wildlife Trust (SWT). The visit will take place on the **22nd November 2024**. The suggested contribution for the visit is £10.50, which includes entry to the Wildlife Centre and a range of activities that the children will take part in to apply their learning and gain invaluable hands-on experiences.

In order to keep the cost to a minimum, we are asking that parents drop off their child at the Wildlife Centre where staff will be waiting to receive the children. If parents wish to make their own arrangements to share lifts for their children, please do so; we would just ask that if someone different is collecting your child please let us know.

Drop off/collection point: ST17 OWT - car park opposite the Wildlife Centre Learning Hub

Arrival time: 9:15am - 9:30am

Collection time 2:30pm

As soon as you have dropped off your child it would be appreciated if parents could return to their cars to leave the site to keep the area clear for other visitors.

What children need to bring with them

Children should be dressed for the weather. Most of the day will be spent outside whatever the weather and, to get the most out of the day, children must be suitably dressed. It is suggested that children wear:

- A warm, waterproof coat (and trousers if available)
- Wellies, walking shoes or strong trainers
- Warm trousers and jumper (sensible outdoor clothing)
- Gloves, hats and scarves if it is cold
- A packed lunch (which can be ordered from the school kitchen if you wish - please let the office have your order by 19th November). As well as a drink for the day.

The preferred form of payment for this trip is via Parent Pay. By paying onto Parent Pay for this trip, we consider that you are also giving your permission for your child to take part in the visit to the Wildlife Centre. Payment and/or permissions should be made by the 19th November please. If you are in receipt of Free School Meals the cost of the visit will be subsidised - please contact Mrs Jones regarding permission.
