Looking ahead:

ENGLISH	This term, Year 1 will be focusing on phonics, using our knowledge to spell and write sentences as well as building our fluency when reading. Year 2 will be focusing on perfecting sentences and ensuring they are grammatically correct, linking our learning to space and Neil Armstrong.
MATHS	This term, Year 1 and 2 have already started to think about number and place value. We have been looking at what each number is worth and how we can partition numbers in a variety of ways. We will then be moving on to addition and subtraction.
TOPIC	Our topic this half term is, 'Changes in Living Memory' and we are focussing on the changes since the 50s. We will be looking at space exploration and changes in transport as well as artists of the 50s and 60s.
SCIENCE	Our Science topic at the end of this half term is 'People and their pets'. We will be thinking about what different pets need and how to care for animals. The children will be able to share their own experiences and we may have some furry visitors to the classroom!
PE	Our PE lessons will focus on gymnastics and dance. We will be thinking about balance and different movements as well as performing dances from other cultures.
RE/ PSHE	In PSHE, we are going to be thinking about citizenship, rules and the importance of school council. Our RE is all about Christianity and creation as well as Harvest.
