


Literacy:

We are starting the year, by reading the wonderful 'Streetchild' by Berlie Doherty, which follows the struggles of a young boy, living in poverty in Victorian London. The children will be focusing on diary entries, story writing and poetry across the half term, using themes and styles from the book. We will also be focusing heavily on the use of grammar and punctuation techniques.

Numeracy:

In Maths, we will begin to learn about place value of 5, 6 and 7 digit numbers, creating number bonds and using different representations to understand the value of each digit. We will also learn about Roman Numerals, with a mixture of varied fluency, problem solving and reasoning tasks.





Science:

In Science, we will be focusing on the wonders of Space. We will learn about the planets within our Solar System, their orbits and the importance of the Moon and the Sun to our existence. The children will study a mixture of theory, using scientific enquiry and also complete some practical investigations.

Topic:

In topic, to coincide with our Victorian topic, we will be studying what Britain looked like during this period of history. We will study and research what life was like for children, including Victorian schools and how poverty affected so many people.

R.E:

In RE this term, our focus will be on the question "Why do Christians believe God is Holy and loving?". Within this, we will focus on God's affect on the everyday lives of Christians and how this impacts their worship.

The children will be starting the year, by learning Gymnastics and Dance. Their focus will be on agility, co-ordination and balance, whilst working both individually and in small groups to produce sequences of moves together.
