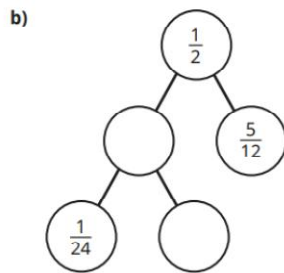
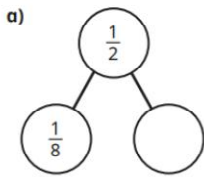

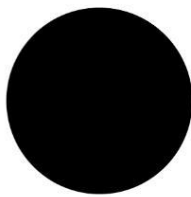

Record the 'phases of the moon' for each day of this week. Which can you spot from the phases shown below:



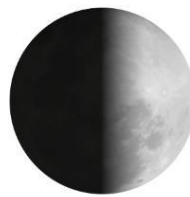
